HENRY C. MOLL

Dr. Henri C. Moll (1952) is presently professor at and temporary director of The Center for Energy and Environmental Studies IVEM at the University of Groningen in the Netherlands. He has been a staff member at IVEM since 1992 and has become research director of the Energy and Materials Department of the IVEM in 1997. He co-ordinated several (interdisciplinary) research projects funded by the Dutch Research Foundation NWO, by the Ministry of Housing, Spatial Planning and the Environment and by the National Research Programme on Global Air Pollution and Climate Change.

On the methodological level his personal research priorities are the further development and application of chain and lifecycle like methodologies (e.g. hybrid methods combining process analysis and input-output analysis) and of system dynamical approaches. Studies addressing the issue of shifting consumption patterns towards sustainability get high priority in his research.

He participated in several international networks concerning lifecycle analysis (LCANET and CHAINET), concerning material flow accounting (ConAccount), and concerning system-modelling and sustainable development the INRIC network (International Network of Resource Information Centers). He was responsible for the Dutch part of the EU sponsored project ToolSust (The involvement of stakeholders to develop and implement tools for sustainable households in the city of tomorrow).

In about two hundred articles, chapters, conference papers, reports and books (both in Dutch and in English) he published on energy and material production and use, on systems analysis and modelling, on household consumption and mobility issues.
